Day 01 – Half Day Visit | Porto

Day 01 – Suggested Restaurant for Dinner | Dom Tonho | Option B)

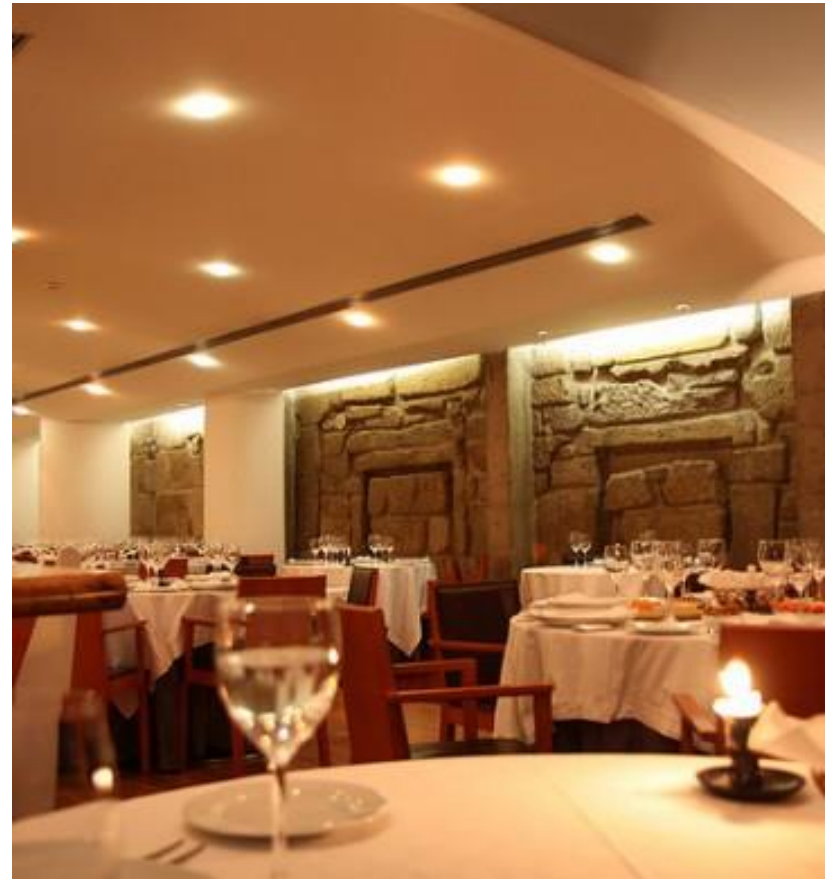
As alternative to the modern facility, we propose a traditional restaurant, located in one of the old boroughs of Porto.

# Minho's Heart

## Day 02 – Full Day Visit to Braga and Guimarães

On this day, we propose guests to discover the main cities of Minho Region, known for its green landscapes.

Starting by Braga, one of the most ancient towns in the country and it is also known as Portugal's religious capital, due to the several beautiful churches in the historic centre and spectacular celebrations of Easter. At the top of the hill, the Bom Jesus de Braga shrine is the ideal spot to have a general panorama over the city and to take a nice group photo.

The ride will go on towards Guimaraes, Portugal's birth place. Classified as World Heritage Site, this town with medieval atmosphere features pleasant narrow streets full of fine shops and nice small restaurants. Overlooking the city, the simple Castle and the Ducal Palace, with its 29 distinctive turrets, will be visited, before returning to the hotel.

Day 02 – Suggested Restaurant for Dinner | Taylor's Restaurant
