

About Porto







An unforgettable visit through Porto old quarters and noble areas of the city.



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Medieval Atmosphere


Day 01 – Suggested Restaurant for Dinner | Dom Tonho | Option 1


Today, we suggest dinner in the historic area of the Ribeira Quarter.

The Music Hall


Day 01 – Suggested Restaurant for Dinner | Casa da Música | Option 2

Day 02 – Full Day Visit | Guimarães


On the second day in Portugal, we propose a visit to Guimarães is an historical city with medieval origin, classified as World Heritage Site in 2001.

This beautiful city is also known as “Nation’s Cradle”, is characterized by a fine labyrinth of narrow streets and old houses that leads to the main square, the Oliveira Square and the Ducal Palace, located on the top of the hill.

Lunch will take place at the Pousada de Guimaraes Restaurant, located on the top of the hill. The magnificent vaulted room was formerly the cellars of this facility that was formerly a monastery convent.

The day will end with a visit to Aveleda property. Known for its wines, the Aveleda is also a magnificent estate of luxuriant vegetation and special corners that seem like they have been taken from a dream...

Day 02 – Suggested Venue for Dinner | FCP Stadium | Option 1

For the farewell dinner, we suggest an informal yet fantastic venue - the Dragon Stadium, where the Porto Soccer Team plays. It holds a wide range of areas where different kind of events can take place.


This flexible venue provides a wide range of areas that can hold from meetings to cocktails or dinners, products presentations...

Day 02 – Suggested Venue | Ferreira Wine Cellars | Option 2


As a traditional option for the last dinner in our beautiful country, we propose a venue that symbolizes the main trade mark of the city of Oporto: the Port Wine. Located in the historic area of Gaia, by the Douro River, these wine cellars have an area especially prepared for events.

With the name of the emblematic figure of D. Antónia Adelaide Ferreira, the Casa Ferreirinha, authored by Paul Wolf, is a unique facility for events, contemporary style, integrated in a wine cellar where there are more than 200 years ages wines of port blacksmith and a museum where guests may discover all about this wine and the founder.

The catering service, is based on the high standards of quality of the brand, offering a rich array of options for events, in line with the renowned wines of trademark Casa Ferreirinha.



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Sunset Cruise along Ribeira

Day 02 - Suggested cruise before dinner at Ferreira Cellars (50 min.)

In order to provide a special experience to our last day, a short cruise along the Douro river, from the Ribeira Quarter to Freixo area and back, in a traditional boat, is a magnificent way to start a special evening.

This way, guests will discover a different perspective of both margins – Porto and Gaia - as pass under the 06 bridges that link the two cities.

When leaving the boat, guests will continue to the cellars building, where dinner will take place.
